XII. Important Points to Note

- 1. Applicants who are selected by the External Links and Exchange Committee of CW Chu College will be given **PROVISIONAL** acceptance to an exchange programme listed in Part VIII, but final confirmation is dependent on the approval by the host institution.
- 2. Students who wish to withdraw their applications for College exchange programmes after the interview stage are required to send a written notification with the reason(s) for withdrawal to the External Links and Exchange Committee via Ms. Alice Tang, College Secretary (Email: <u>alicet@cuhk.edu.hk</u>) for internal record. The College will <u>NOT</u> arrange refund of exchange deposit (HK\$1,000) to the student concerned under normal circumstances.
- 3. Students joining College exchange programmes are required to fulfill the minimum course load requirement set by CUHK (i.e. 9 units of courses per term and passing at least 6 of them per term or the equivalent) during their exchange periods. Students who fail to meet this basic requirement will <u>NOT</u> be granted College exchange scholarships/ subsidies or such offers will be withdrawn by the College.
- 4. To ensure students have equal opportunities for participation in outbound exchange, those who receive exchange offers from both OAL and the College in 2025–26 can only accept either **ONE** of the offers (even the two exchange programmes will be carried out in different terms of the academic year).

5. Special Reminders from OAL and the Registration and Examination Section (RES)

- Students who wish to participate in a term-time exchange after their expected graduation date must NOT have earned all credit units required for graduation before they go on exchange.
- Students under this category can go on exchange for one academic term only which must take place immediately after their last active academic term (excluding summer term) at CUHK (For example, A student who is expected to graduate by Term 2, 2024–25 can only go on exchange in Term 1 of 2025–26 subject to the approval of RES on his/ her application for extension of study).

6. Arrangements on Hostel Accommodation & Communal Dining for Outgoing Exchange Students

- i) Students who have been granted a confirmed offer by the College/ OAL/ any other CUHK units for participation in term-time exchange programmes are required to
 - apply for suspension of studies via their home departments and RES well in advance; and
 - submit a special application for exemption from hostel lodging and communal dining during their exchange periods to the College for formal approval by 31 May of the previous academic year. Details will be announced by the College via email.
- ii) Based on the mutual agreements between CUHK/CWC and their exchange partners, the hostel place released by an outgoing exchange student of CWC will be allocated to an incoming exchange student.
- iii) The gap in residence due to participation in U-wide/ College/ departmental exchange programmes will still be counted as part of the four-year guaranteed hostel residence (less than 4 years of hostel entitlement for students who are admitted with Advanced Standing/ Senior Year channel) offered by College to the CWC student concerned. Should the student want a hostel place beyond the period of entitlement, he/ she is required to submit a special application to the Student Affairs Committee for consideration by following the standard guidelines and deadline set by the College. That application, if received, will be reviewed together with all other similar applications

by the Committee. Details and relevant clauses of such kind of special applications will be announced via email in due course.
